**ALEXANDER, AR** – Republican Keith Kellum, a 30-year resident of the Avilla community, officially announced his candidacy for Saline County Quorum Court, district 4, which covers Avilla, Lake Norrell, Paron, portions of Alexander and East-Northeast Saline County.

Keith and his wife Terry of 37 years have raised three children in the Avilla community, and their children attended Bryant School District. Keith was originally from North Little Rock where he was a 1977 graduate of Northeast High School. After high school, he attended the University of Arkansas and Capitol City Jr. College.

Kellum retired from Bale Chevrolet in 2021 and retired from the U.S. Navy and Naval Reserves in 2006, where he served his nation with distinction for twenty years serving in supply, logistics and sealift port operations for several deployments to Korea, Operation Noble Anvil during the Kosovo Campaign, the Middle East during the Persian Gulf War era, and Operation Enduring Freedom after 9/11.

He served as Campaign manager for a mayoral candidate in North Little Rock in 1992 and played an active role in the successful 1992 Term Limits Amendment.

Keith is a strong supporter of the second amendment and is currently an Arkansas State Police certified Concealed Handgun Carry Instructor (CHCL) and NRA Pistol Instructor.

He is an active member of the Saline County Republican Committee and a voting member of the Second Congressional District Republican Party of Arkansas

Keith said, "I am a lifelong constitutional conservative Republican, and I am concerned with the direction our community is taking, as well as our state and nation. I am running on a very conservative platform to make sure Saline County remains a deep red county. I have real world experience, that will apply to real world problems that all of us deal with daily.
